

## Comparison High School Graduation and CSU/UC Admission Requirements

	High School Graduation Requirements	UC and CSU Admission (Minimum) Requirements
<b>English</b>	4 years (40 credits)	4 years
<b>History</b>	3 years (30 credits)	2 years
<b>Mathematics</b>	3 years (30 credits)	3 years (must complete Algebra 2) (UC recommends 4 yrs)
<b>Science</b>	2 years (20 credits)	2 years (must be lab classes) (UC recommends 3 yrs)
<b>Fine Arts / Foreign Language</b>	1 year (10 credits) (Either / Or)	1 year (Fine Arts)
<b>Foreign Language</b>		2 years (UC recommends 3 yrs)
<b>Health Education</b>	.5 year (5 credits)	
<b>Technology Proficiency</b>	.5 year (5 credits)	
<b>Physical Education</b>	2 years (20 credits)	
<b>Electives</b>	(80 credits)	1 year

- ◆ Students must have a total of 240 credits to graduate from high school
- ◆ Students must pass the High School Exit Exam prior to graduation  
(The High School Exit Exam includes: reading writing and math)
- ◆ College Entrance Testing:  
Students applying to 4 year colleges must take SAT or ACT tests
